Online Application

- 1. Letter of Motivation (please without contact information)
- 2. Secondary School Diploma (predicted grades or mid-term report card)
- 3. Proof of English Proficiency
- 4. Proof of Internship

Missing documents and further steps of the application process will be provided to the applicants via email.





Evaluation of the Applications

The Admissions Team will regularly evaluate the received applications. Depending on the case, successful candidates will receive an invitation to the selection process.



Selection Process

The Rolling Admissions are individual Admission Rounds, which are only offered to selected applicants with very good school grades. If you have already provided your Proof of English Proficiency, your chances of being considered for the Rolling Admissions are considerably higher. If your application does not meet the criteria for Rolling Admissions, you may still be invited to Round 1. Alternatively you can also apply directly for the Admission Round 1, 2 or 3. All Admission Rounds contain the same steps, and the information about deadlines and dates can be found on our website.
