

13th ACMAR Doctoral Colloquium - February 28-29, 2024

Call for Submissions

Introduction

In 2024, the ACMAR Doctoral Colloquium will be held again in conjunction with the Annual Conference for Management Accounting Research (ACMAR) at WHU – Otto Beisheim School of Management (Campus Vallendar, Germany).

The colloquium's objective is to provide an opportunity for doctoral students to discuss their research with an experienced faculty. Thus, early-stage work of young researchers will benefit the most from the colloquium.

In addition to the academic program, the colloquium agenda will provide sufficient opportunity for students to interact informally with other participants and the faculty.

The ACMAR Doctoral Colloquium will take place on February 28-29, 2024, preceding of the 21st ACMAR. The event will start on Wednesday morning with presentations, ceasing by a joint dinner that evening. Presentations will continue on Thursday morning. Participating students are also encouraged to attend the 21st ACMAR that will commence on Thursday, February 29, 2024.

Faculty

The external faculty for the colloquium will include **Professor Melissa Martin** (University of Illinois Chicago), and **Professor Afshin Mehrpouya** (University of Edinburgh).

Costs

The participation fee for the colloquium will be 150 EUR per person, including colloquium materials, lunch, dinner, and refreshments during the colloquium.

Application

Applications should be submitted no later December 3, 2023.

Applications should be submitted via email to acmar@whu.edu and must encompass an extended abstract of approximately 3-5 pages (single-spaced, 11pt Times New Roman) and a one-page CV (combined in one PDF Document). The extended abstract should clearly highlight the motivation for the research project, theories and methods used, and potential contributions to the literature. Ten students will be accepted and are required to prepare a presentation for the colloquium.

Venue and contact

The 13th ACMAR Doctoral Colloquium will be held at WHU campus Vallendar, which is around one hour away from Frankfurt (Main) Airport and from Cologne/Bonn Airport, either by car or by train. A direct train connection (RE 8) runs from Cologne/Bonn to Vallendar.
