## **Getting started**

Before you embark on writing, we encourage you to draft a proposal or short exposé and discuss it with the editorial team to ensure alignment with our journal's interests. It should contain your **topic** and **core messages** and be accompanied by **practical examples** and **recommendations for action**.

On this basis, create a text spanning 8,000 to a maximum of 15,000 characters, including spaces, corresponding to about four journal pages. Ensure adherence to our style sheet, available at <a href="https://www.whu.edu/cmr">www.whu.edu/cmr</a>.

Begin your article in an engaging manner, e.g., by using a question, a real-world example, or another captivating stylistic device. The article should be clear and readable, using an active voice. Please avoid using nested sentences and excessive substantiations or abbreviations.
